

## Job Description 2022

**Job Title:** Campus Security- Full Time

**Reports to:** Principal

**Supervises:** Campus Security, SFC volunteers when applicable

**Salary:** \$15/hr

### Goal and Professional Responsibilities:

- Ensures security and safety of students, faculty, and staff.
- Patrols campus and maintains security of buildings and grounds.
- Directs traffic and parking on campus; checks vehicles for proper parking authorization; determines if vehicles are parked in restricted areas.
- Helps create and maintain a working relationship with the local police, fire, and rescue departments.
- Assists in the development and implementation of action plans to provide a safe environment and immediate response to imminent threats of violence, criminal incidents, emergency medical incidents, auto accidents and others.
- Conducts emergency drills.
- Patrols and confronts unauthorized persons for questioning and checking for passes and identification cards, as needed.
- Supervises and patrols assigned school activities.
- Monitors video footage of campus to assess and mitigate any threat.
- Performs other duties as assigned by school administration.

### Physical Requirements:

- Sitting, standing, lifting and carrying (up to 40 pounds), climbing stairs, reaching, squatting, kneeling, having full mobility of fingers/hands, and walking several hours per day in hallways and outside, unless ADA accommodations have been mutually agreed on and does not create an undue hardship upon SFC.

### Spiritual Qualifications:

- A genuinely regenerated and separated Christian who gives evidence of growing in grace and living in faith and obedience to God and His Word
- Has a clear testimony of faith in Christ, will sign the school's statement of faith, and will endorse SFC's code of ethics/lifestyle statement.

- One who is able to clearly articulate the biblical components of salvation, citing appropriate Scripture passages, in order to be able to lead a child to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- One who is faithful in attendance to, and is actively involved in, a local evangelical church
- One with a shepherd spirit in caring for those under his or her charge (1 Peter 5:2– 3)
- A firm and fair disciplinarian who tempers discipline with compassion (Proverbs 22:6)

**Academic qualifications:**

- High School diploma or GED required.
- Private security or public police experience, preferred.

**Additional Qualifications**

- Ability to meet state and federal requirements, including yearly background checks and fingerprinting.
- Ability to complete Security Level 1 Training (upon hiring).

**Highly Recommended**

- Current CPR/Basic First Aid card, or the ability to obtain one within 30 days of hire.
